One of CeDAMar's most ambitious objectives is to formally describe 500 new deep-sea species by 2010. In order to achieve this goal, they plan to publish a series of monographic volumes on deep- sea taxonomy and systematics. The next volume is planned for the beginning of 2008 in the journal Zootaxa.

The objectives of this meeting include the selection of a new OBIS Managers Committee chair, review of progress in development of Regional OBIS Nodes and identify topics for the roundtable and focused discussions following oral presentations by OBIS MC members. It is expected that the IOBIS Portal and most RONs will be represented, with some 20 participants from Australia, Canada, China, Japan, Argentina, Chile, USA and regional representatives of Europe, Indian Ocean, South Western Pacific and Sub-Saharan Africa.
